TAKE NOTICE that the High Court of Australia will sit as the Court of Disputed Returns pursuant to s 376 of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act* 1918 (Cth) at 10:15am (AEST) on Thursday 24 August 2017 at the Commonwealth Law Courts Building, 119 North Quay, Brisbane, for the purpose of giving directions as to the hearing and determination by the Court of Disputed Returns of the following questions transmitted by the Senate on Thursday 10 August 2017 pursuant to s 377 of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act* 1918 (Cth):

- (a) whether by reason of s 44(i) of the Constitution there is a vacancy in the representation of Queensland in the Senate for the place for which Senator Roberts was returned:
- (b) if the answer to Question (a) is 'yes', by what means and in what manner that vacancy should be filled;
- (c) what directions and other orders, if any, should the Court make in order to hear and finally dispose of this reference; and
- (d) what, if any, orders should be made as to the costs of these proceedings.

Any person who desires to place any evidence before or make any submission to the Court should apply to the Court by email addressed to Senate.Reference.Roberts@hcourt.gov.au by 12:00noon on Monday 21 August 2017 setting out the reasons why they should be granted leave to appear before the Court. The Court may determine such application on the papers or invite the person to appear and make oral submissions to the Court in Brisbane (or by video-link if required) at 10:15am (AEST) on Thursday 24 August 2017.
