25 October 1991 Appellant commits offence of attempted rape; sentenced to

imprisonment for three years with a non-parole period of 18

months. (CAB 26 [8])

13 November 1993 Appellant commits offences of attempted rape and false

imprisonment. (CAB 26 [9])

29 April 1994 Appellant sentenced for the 13 November 1993 offences of

attempted rape and false imprisonment, to imprisonment for four years and three months with a non-parole period of four

years. (CAB 26 [9])

	28 October 1997	Appellant commits indecent assault at Port Lincoln; sentenced to imprisonment for two years, four months and 15 days.  (CAB 26 [10])
	25 April 2002	Appellant commits the offences of assault with intent to rape and aggravated serious criminal trespass and on 5 February 2003 is convicted for those offences. ( <b>CAB 24</b> [2], [6])
	26 July 2005	Appellant sentenced for the offences of 25 April 2002 to imprisonment for ten years imprisonment, that sentence to commence from 29 April 2002. (CAB 8 [6], CAB 24 [3])
10	4 November 2011	The Supreme Court of South Australia (Gray J) makes an order pursuant to s 23 of the <i>Criminal Law (Sentencing) Act 1988</i> (SA) that the appellant be detained in custody until further order. ( <b>CAB 14</b> [29], [30])
	29 April 2012	End of the sentence of imprisonment imposed on the appellant on 26 July 2005. (CAB 14 [30])
	6 November 2017	Appellant files application for release on license pursuant to s 24 of the <i>Criminal Law (Sentencing) Act.</i> ( <b>CAB 24</b> [5])
20	30 April 2018	Sentencing Act 2017 (SA) commences operation. Criminal Law (Sentencing) Act repealed. Section 59 of the Sentencing Act replaces s 24 of the Criminal Law (Sentencing) Act.
	25 June 2018	Sentencing (Release on Licence) Amendment Act 2018 (SA) commences operation, amending ss 57-59 of the Sentencing Act.
	13 September 2018 to	
	10 December 2019	The appellant's application for release on licence heard by the Supreme Court, first by Hinton J and then by Kourakis CJ. (CAB 24 [5])

	26 August 2020	The Supreme Court of South Australia (Kourakis CJ) refuses the appellant's application for release on licence: <i>Wichen v The Queen</i> [2020] SASC 157. ( <b>CAB 22-54</b> )
	16 December 2020	Appellant files a notice of appeal to the Court of Appeal against the decision refusing the application for release on license. (CAB 60-62)
	7 May 2021	Court of Appeal (Kelly P, Lovell and Bleby JJ) dismiss the appeal: <i>Wichen v The Queen</i> (2021) 138 SASR 134. (CAB 64-78)
10	4 June 2021	Appellant files application for Special Leave to Appeal to the High Court of Australia.
	21 February 2022	Special leave to appeal granted. (CAB 81)
	4 March 2022	Appellant files Notice of Appeal to the High Court of Australia. (CAB 84-85)
