Date	Event	Appeal book reference
31 December 2013	The Appellant, Mr Prior, was apprehended and taken into custody by police under s 128 of the <i>Police Administration Act 1979</i> (NT). The Appellant was charged with: behaving in a disorderly manner in a public place contrary to s 47(a) of the <i>Summary Offences Act 1923</i> (NT) ( <b>count 1</b> ); behaving in an indecent manner in a public place contrary to s 47(a) of the <i>Summary Offences Act 1923</i> (NT) ( <b>count 2</b> ); and unlawfully assaulting a police officer contrary to s 189A of the <i>Criminal Code 1983</i> (NT) ( <b>count 3</b> ).	
14 May 2014	Cavanagh SM in the Court of Summary Jurisdiction found the apprehension was lawful pursuant to s 128(1) of the <i>Police Administration Act 1979</i> (NT). Cavanagh SM convicted the Appellant of count 2 and 3.	
15 May 2014	The Appellant appealed to the Supreme Court against his convictions.

6 October 2014	Hearing before Southwood J in the Supreme Court of the Northern Territory.
29 September 2015	Southwood J delivered written judgment acquitting the Appellant of count 2 and 3 (unlawfully assaulting a police officer contrary to s 189A of the <i>Criminal Code</i> and behaving in an indecent manner contrary to s 47(a) of the <i>Summary Offences Act</i> ).
26 October 2015	The Respondent appealed the Appellant's acquittal to the Court of Appeal.
3 February 2016	Hearing before the Court of Appeal, comprising Riley CJ, Kelly and Hiley JJ.
3 March 2016	The Court of Appeal, comprising Riley CJ, Kelly and Hiley JJ, set aside the order of the Supreme Court and reinstated the convictions on counts 2 and 3.
1 September 2016	Special leave to appeal granted by the High Court of Australia, comprising Gageler and Gordon JJ.
15 September 2016	Appellant's Notice of Appeal filed.
