

- 5 The respondent published an article titled "Bashed your quota of Muslims today?" in the "Daily Telegraph" about the stoning to death of a woman for adultery in Nigeria. August 2002
- 40 6 The respondent was quoted in an article titled "Sheikh and Stir" published in the "Weekend Australian" about responsibility for the September 11 attacks. 14-15 September


