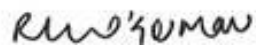

20 October 2022	The primary judge refused the appellant's application to exclude the record of interview.	CAB 43
17 April 2023 – 20 April 2023	The appellant was tried in the Supreme Court for one count of murder. Sentence passed.	CAB 43-44

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16 September 2025	The appellant's appeal against conviction was dismissed by the Court of Appeal.	CAB 42
