1           The applicant requires an extension of time in which to seek leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of South Australia (Livesey ACJ and Bleby JA) on 13 July 2023.<sup>1</sup> The Court of Appeal dismissed the applicant's application for leave to appeal against a decision of the District Court of South Australia (Judge Dart), which dismissed an application for an extension of time to appeal and an appeal against a decision of a District Court Master appointing a litigation guardian to the applicant.

2           The Court of Appeal's judgment was plainly correct. Consequently, it would be futile to grant the necessary extension of time. Special leave to appeal is refused.
