- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Victoria (Beach, McLeish, Kennedy JJA) dismissing the applicant's appeal against convictions for drug offences.
- 2 The application has insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave to appeal. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
