LEE v STAR AGED LIVING LIMITED [2024] HCASL 167 B16/2024

- The applicant seeks an extension of time to apply for special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Bowskill CJ, Bond and Flanagan JJA), allowing an appeal from a judgment of a single judge of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Mellifont J).²
- The Court of Appeal's judgment is not attended by sufficient doubt to warrant a grant of special leave to appeal. Accordingly, it would be futile to grant the extension of time sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
