- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Victoria (Beach and Niall JJA), which dismissed appeals from two judgments of the Supreme Court of Victoria (Ginnane J).
- 2 There is no reason to doubt the correctness of the Court of Appeal's judgment. It would therefore be futile to grant an extension of time.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
