KBG v THE KING [2024] HCASL 289 B38/2024

- The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Mullins P and Dalton JA; Davis J dissenting) which dismissed an appeal against convictions following a trial by jury in the District Court of Queensland (Chowdhury DCJ).
- The proposed ground of appeal lacks sufficient prospects of success to warrant the grant of special leave to appeal. Accordingly, it would be futile to grant the extension of time.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
