- 1 The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from orders of the Full Court of the Federal Court of Australia (Cheeseman, Goodman and McEvoy JJ), including orders dismissing an appeal from a judgment of the Federal Court of Australia (Charlesworth J), which in turn had dismissed the applicant's originating application for judicial review of the Registrar's decision to refuse to accept for filing documents lodged by the applicant, on the basis that the documents did not disclose a decision that was capable of review by the Federal Court.
- 2 The application presents no reason to doubt the correctness of the Full Court's decision. An appeal to this Court would enjoy no prospects of success.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
