LIESCHKE v LIESCHKE & ORS [2024] HCASL 66 S147/2023

The applicant applies for an extension of time in which to seek special leave to appeal from the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of New South Wales (Leeming, Payne and Beech-Jones JJA) given on 13 October 2023.¹ The application involves no question of law and is not attended by sufficient doubt to warrant a grant of special leave to appeal. Accordingly, it would be futile to grant an extension of time.

Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
