WU v WU [2025] HCADisp 57 C2/2025

The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of the Australian Capital Territory (Mossop, Baker and McWilliam JJ) of 16 December 2024 which confirmed the costs order made by the Court of Appeal on 14 November 2024.

On the basis that the applicant seeks special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgments of the Court of Appeal (Mossop, Baker and McWilliam JJ) of 12 July, 14 November and 16 December 2024, the application for special leave to appeal does not raise a question of law of public importance and any appeal would have no prospects of success. It is not in the interests of the administration of justice, either generally or in this case, for special leave to appeal to be granted.

Special leave to appeal is refused.
