- 1 The applicants require an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from part of a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of New South Wales (Ward P and Mitchelmore JA) given on 8 November 2023 in which the Court of Appeal dismissed with costs a notice of motion filed by the applicants on 17 August 2023 seeking to set aside and vary earlier orders made by the Court of Appeal on 3 August 2023.
- 2 The proposed appeal does not have sufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave. Nor does it raise any question of law of general application or public importance. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
