- 1 The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Victoria (Beach JA) dismissing three applications seeking leave to appeal from various orders of the Supreme Court of Victoria in relation to probate and passing over proceedings, namely: pre-trial procedural orders made on 14 September 2023 concerning a joint trial (John Dixon J); pre-trial and final orders made on 19 March 2024 and 23 May 2024 (O'Meara J); and post-trial orders made on 14 November 2024 upholding decisions made by the Prothonotary rejecting and refusing to seal proposed notices of appeal (Quigley J).
- 2 There is no reason to doubt the correctness of the decision of the Court of Appeal, and the interests of the administration of justice are strongly against a grant of special leave to appeal.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
