

*IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION BY YOUHUA MAO FOR LEAVE TO
APPEAL*

- 1 The applicant seeks leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of a single judge of the High Court of Australia (Gordon J), dismissing an application for leave to issue or file a writ of summons. The applicant also filed an interlocutory application seeking leave to amend their originating application for leave to appeal.
- 2 The proposed appeal, whether in its original or proposed amended form, would not enjoy sufficient prospects of success to warrant the grant of leave to appeal. It would therefore be futile to grant leave to amend the originating application for leave to appeal.
- 3 Leave to appeal is refused.
