- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Australian Capital Territory (Refshauge A-J, McWilliam and Taylor JJ agreeing) dismissing an appeal from orders of the Supreme Court of the Australian Capital Territory (McCallum CJ), (1) removing the respondent as the defendant to proceedings brought by the applicant; (2) ordering that the applicant pay the respondent's costs; and (3) dismissing the proceedings.
- 2 There is no reason to doubt the correctness of the decision of the Court of Appeal, and the interests of the administration of justice are strongly against a grant of special leave to appeal.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
