GRIMM v THE KING [2025] HCADisp 154 M26/2025

- The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Victoria (Priest, Kennedy and T Forrest JJA), dismissing an appeal from conviction, following the refusal by the County Court of Victoria (Judge Todd) of an application by the applicant for leave to withdraw his pleas of guilty.
- The application has insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave to appeal and is otherwise an unsuitable vehicle for consideration of the questions of principle raised. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
