## INFOSYS TECHNOLOGIES LIMITED

## *v FOX*[2025] HCADisp 153 B16/2025

- The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Bond JA, Brown JA and Crow J agreeing) which dismissed an appeal from a decision of the Full Bench of the Queensland Industrial Relations Commission (Davis J P, O'Connor VP and Hartigan DP) which found in favour of the respondent, concerning the payment of long service leave under the *Industrial Relations Act 2016* (Qld).
- The application provides no reason to doubt the unanimous decision of the Court of Appeal, which construed s 93 of the *Industrial Relations Act* 2016 (Qld) consistently with orthodox principles of statutory interpretation. The proposed appeal has insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
