- 1 The applicants seek special leave to appeal from a decision of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of South Australia (Livesey P, S Doyle and Bleby JJA), which dismissed the applicants' appeal against a decision of the Supreme Court of South Australia (Bampton J).
- 2 The application for special leave to appeal does not raise a question of law of public importance and any appeal would have no prospects of success. It is not in the interests of the administration of justice, either generally or in this case, for special leave to appeal to be granted.
- 3 The applicants' application for leave to file supplementary documents dated 12 June 2025 is refused.
- 4 Special leave to appeal is refused.
