PBO v THE KING [2025] HCADisp 164 B14/2025

- The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from the whole of a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Bowskill CJ, Boddice JA and Doyle A-JA), which dismissed an appeal against the applicant's conviction of sexual offences following a trial by jury in the Supreme Court of Queensland.
- The proposed appeal does not raise any issue of principle and has insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
