KWLD v MAGISTRATE WEBB & ORS [2025] HCADisp 193 P26/2025

- The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from part of a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Western Australia (Buss P, Vaughan and Archer JJA), which dismissed an appeal from a judgment of the Supreme Court of Western Australia (Howard J), which in turn dismissed an application for a review order in respect of a dismissal by the Magistrates Court of Western Australia (Magistrate Webb) of an application under s 151(4) of the *Criminal Investigation Act 2006* (WA).
- The proposed appeal does not raise any issue of general principle and has insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
