ROCK v HENDERSON [2025] HCADisp 199 S54/2025

- The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of New South Wales (Kirk, Adamson and Ball JJA), which allowed in part an appeal from a judgment of the District Court of New South Wales (Olsson SC DCJ).
- The application for special leave to appeal has insufficient prospects of success. It is not in the interests of the administration of justice, either generally or in this case, for special leave to appeal to be granted. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
