- 1 The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Full Court of the Supreme Court of Tasmania (Porter AJ, Shanahan CJ and Cuthbertson J agreeing), which dismissed the applicant's appeal against a judgment of the Supreme Court of Tasmania (Marshall AJ), which, in turn, had dismissed the applicant's notice to review a decision of a magistrate (Geason CM), which found proven a complaint that the applicant had failed to comply with a building order contrary to s 246 of the *Building Act 2016* (Tas).
- 2 The application for special leave to appeal has no prospects of success. It is not in the interests of the administration of justice, either generally or in this case, for special leave to appeal to be granted.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
