- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Western Australia (Mitchell, Hall and Archer JJA), which dismissed an appeal from the Supreme Court of Western Australia (Lemonis J).
- 2 The proposed appeal does not raise any issue of principle and has insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
