ROSSI v QANTAS AIRWAYS LIMITED [2025] HCADisp 55 S161/2024

- The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Full Court of the Federal Court of Australia (Snaden, Hatcher and Horan JJ) dismissing an appeal from a judgment of the Federal Court of Australia (Banks-Smith J) which dismissed an application for orders declaring that the applicant is a handicapped person within the meaning of O 15 of the *County Court Rules of Procedure in Civil Proceedings 1999* (Vic) and that a deed of settlement made between the parties is void.
- The proposed appeal would enjoy insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave to appeal. Further, the application does not raise any issue of law of general application or public importance.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
