TOWNSVILLE CITY COUNCIL v VATSONIC COMMUNICATIONS PTY LTD & ORS [2025] HCADisp 9 B58/2024

- The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Bowskill CJ, Boddice JA and Henry J agreeing) which upheld an appeal in part from the District Court of Queensland (Coker DCJ).
- The proposed appeal does not raise any point of general principle and does not have sufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave to appeal. It would therefore be futile to grant an extension of time.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
