- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Dalton and Boddice JJA, Burns J), in which the Court of Appeal dismissed an appeal against conviction.
- 2 The proposed appeal does not raise any question of legal principle and has insufficient prospects of success for it to be in the interests of the administration of justice for special leave to be granted. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
