- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Mullins P, Gotterson A-JA and Crow J), which refused the applicant's application for leave to appeal against sentence.
- 2 The application for special leave does not raise any question of public importance or legal principle for which the matter could function as an appropriate vehicle to resolve and otherwise has insufficient prospects of success to justify a grant of special leave. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
