- 1       The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Mullins P, Doyle JA and Cooper J), which dismissed an appeal from the judgment of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Smith J), which dismissed both an application for an order setting aside an enforcement warrant and an application for review of costs assessments.
- 2       The proposed application does not give rise to any question of law of general application or public importance, nor does it have sufficient prospects of success, to warrant a grant of special leave.
- 3       Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
