1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of South Australia (S Doyle and Bleby JJA), which summarily dismissed the applicant's appeal from a decision of the Legal Practitioners Disciplinary Tribunal.

2 There is no reason to doubt the correctness of the decision of the Court of Appeal that the proposed appeal was an abuse of process. The extension of time sought would perpetuate that abuse and accordingly is refused.

3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
