

*IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION BY KESTER MIRANDA FOR LEAVE
TO APPEAL*

- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek leave to appeal from an order made by a Justice of this Court (Jagot J) on 4 June 2025, which dismissed an *ex parte* application for leave to issue or file a writ of summons against Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Limited as defendant on the basis that the proposed writ was frivolous and vexatious on its face, involving an abuse of process if permitted to be filed.
- 2 The application does not raise any arguable ground of appeal. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
- 3 Leave to appeal is refused.
