- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from the whole of a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of South Australia (Livesey P, S Doyle and David JJA) granting permission to appeal but dismissing the appeal against conviction.
- 2 The proposed appeal does not involve a question of law that is of public importance and does not have sufficient prospects of success for it to be in the interests of the administration of justice for special leave to be granted. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
