- 1       The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from part of the judgment of the Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia (Division 1) Appellate Jurisdiction (Austin, Sutherland and Riethmuller JJ), which dismissed an appeal against the interlocutory judgment of the Family Court of Western Australia (Cohen J), which relevantly made orders giving effect to orders finalising a cause of action between the parties concerning the division of their property under Pt VIII of the *Family Law Act 1975* (Cth).
- 2       The application for special leave to appeal has insufficient prospects of success. It is not in the interests of the administration of justice, either generally or in this case, for special leave to appeal to be granted.
- 3       Special leave to appeal is refused.
