1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from orders of the Full Court of the Federal Court of Australia (Cheeseman, Goodman and McEvoy JJ) which ordered, pursuant to s 37AO(2)(b) of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (Cth), that the applicant be prohibited from instituting proceedings in the Federal Court without leave.

2 The proposed appeal would enjoy no prospects of success. It is therefore futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.

3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
