- 1 The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Full Court of the Federal Court of Australia (Collier, Jackman and Younan JJ) which dismissed the applicant's appeal from the judgment of the Federal Court of Australia (Rangiah J) which dismissed the applicant's application for judicial review of a decision of the respondent made under s 501BA of the *Migration Act 1958* (Cth).
- 2 The application does not raise any question of general principle and there is insufficient reason to doubt the correctness of the decision of the Full Court to warrant a grant of special leave to appeal.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
