- 1       The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Victoria (Beach, Richards and Kaye JJA), which dismissed an application for an extension of time within which to seek leave to appeal from a decision of the County Court of Victoria (Manova J), which in turn dismissed the applicant's application for leave to bring common law proceedings for loss of earning capacity pursuant to s 335 of the *Workplace Injury Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2013* (Vic).
  
- 2       The application for special leave to appeal has insufficient prospects of success. It is not in the interests of the administration of justice, either generally or in this case, for special leave to appeal to be granted. It would accordingly be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
  
- 3       Special leave to appeal is refused.
