- 1 The applicant seeks an extension of time within which to apply for special leave to appeal from the whole of two judgments of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of New South Wales (Payne, McHugh and Free JJA) which refused leave to appeal from judgments and orders made in the Supreme Court of New South Wales (Slattery J) and associated costs orders (Kunc J, Price A-JA, Adamson JA and Lindsay J), relating to proceedings commenced by the applicant against his former partner concerning the sale of two properties following orders made by the Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia.

- 2 The proposed appeal does not raise an issue of law of public importance and has insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.

- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
