- 1 The applicant applies for special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Full Court of the Federal Court of Australia (Stewart, Meagher and Longbottom JJ), which allowed an appeal from a judgment of the Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia (Division 2) (Judge Egan), which dismissed the respondent's discrimination claim under the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992* (Cth).
- 2 The proposed appeal does not raise a question of public importance given its fact-specific context and has insufficient prospects of success for it to be in the interests of the administration of justice to grant special leave to appeal.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
