- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Victoria (Richards JA) which dismissed the applicant's application for leave to appeal from the judgment of the Supreme Court of Victoria (Finanzio J) which, in turn, had dismissed the applicant's appeal from the judgment of Ierodionou AsJ and discharged a stay of execution of a warrant of possession of a property.
- 2 There is no reason to doubt the correctness of the decision of the Court of Appeal that the applicant's application for leave to appeal was totally without merit. Accordingly, it would be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
