1       The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia (Division 1) Appellate Jurisdiction (McClelland DCJ), which dismissed an appeal from a decision of the Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia (Division 2) (Judge Hughes), which in turn made orders with respect to the transfer of certain property between the parties pursuant to the *Family Law Act 1975* (Cth).

2       The application for special leave to appeal has insufficient prospects of success. It is not in the interests of the administration of justice, either generally or in this case, for special leave to appeal to be granted. It would accordingly be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.

3       Special leave to appeal is refused.
