- 1       The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Queensland (Bond, Brown and Doyle JJA), which dismissed the applicant's appeal from the Childrens Court of Queensland (constituted by a Childrens Court judge) which, in turn, dismissed the applicant's appeal from the orders made by the Childrens Court (constituted by a Childrens Court magistrate) granting long-term guardianship of three children under s 61(f)(iii) of the *Child Protection Act 1999* (Qld) to the chief executive.
  
- 2       The application does not raise any question of general principle and there is no reason to doubt the correctness of the decision of the Court of Appeal to warrant a grant of special leave to appeal.
  
- 3       Special leave to appeal is refused.
