1 The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from part of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Victoria (John Dixon AJA), which refused the applicant's application for leave to appeal from orders made by the Supreme Court of Victoria (K Judd J) which, in turn, dismissed an appeal from a determination made by a judicial registrar of the Supreme Court concerning an exercise of discretion on a point of practice and procedure.

2 The application does not raise any question of general principle and there is no reason to doubt the correctness of the decision of the Court of Appeal to warrant a grant of special leave to appeal.

3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
