1 The applicant applies for special leave to appeal from part of the judgment of the Court of Criminal Appeal of the Supreme Court of New South Wales (Mitchelmore JA, Ierace and McNaughton JJ), which granted leave to appeal against conviction but dismissed the appeal and refused leave to appeal against sentence.

2 The proposed appeal does not raise a question of law of public importance and has insufficient prospects of success for it to be in the interests of the administration of justice for special leave to be granted.

3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
