1           The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Victoria (Priest, Osborn and Kaye JJA) which allowed the respondent's appeal against sentence and resented the applicant.

2           The application for special leave to appeal does not raise a point of principle and has insufficient prospects of success. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.

3           Special leave to appeal is refused.
