- 1       The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Western Australia (Vaughan, Hall and Archer JJA), which dismissed an appeal from the District Court of Western Australia (Astill DCJ) in which the applicant was convicted of 23 offences.
  
- 2       The application for special leave to appeal has insufficient prospects of success. It is not in the interests of the administration of justice, either generally or in this case, for special leave to appeal to be granted. It would accordingly be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
  
- 3       Special leave to appeal is refused.
