- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from part of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Western Australia (Hall JA, Dalton AJA, Vandongen JA dissenting), which dismissed the applicant's appeal against conviction.
- 2 The application does not raise any question of general principle and there are insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave to appeal. It would accordingly be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
