- 1 The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from part of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of South Australia (Livesey P, Stanley JA and Mitchell AJA), which relevantly dismissed in part the applicant's appeal from a decision of the Supreme Court of South Australia (McDonald J).
- 2 The applicant has not identified a question of law sufficient to warrant the grant of special leave to appeal and otherwise advances no arguable ground of appeal against the decision of the Court of Appeal. It is otherwise not in the interests of the administration of justice, either generally or in this case, for special leave to appeal to be granted.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
