- 1 The applicant requires an extension of time within which to seek special leave to appeal from the whole of the judgment of the Court of Appeal of the Supreme Court of Western Australia (Thomson P, Mitchell JA and Bydder J), which dismissed an appeal against conviction, following a jury trial before Judge Bowden in the District Court of Western Australia.
- 2 The proposed appeal has insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave and does not raise a point of general public importance. It would therefore be futile to grant the extension of time that is sought.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused.
