- 1 The applicant seeks special leave to appeal from a judgment of the Full Court of the Federal Court of Australia (Moshinsky, S C Derrington and Stellios JJ), which dismissed an appeal from a judgment of the Federal Court of Australia (Feutrill J), which in turn dismissed the applicant's claim for declarations against the respondent concerning the use of materials sent by the Attorney-General's Department to authorities in the United Kingdom under the *Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1987* (Cth).
- 2 The application has insufficient prospects of success to warrant a grant of special leave and is not a suitable vehicle for adjudicating the applicant's complaint.
- 3 Special leave to appeal is refused with costs.
